

## Resources for Environmental Health for Child Care

### Lead Resources

**City of Grand Rapids Lead Hazard Control Program** – Provides grants and loans to address all lead hazards in residential properties where children are present 24 hours per week or more. **(616) 456-3030**

**State of Michigan Lead Hazard Control Program** – Provides grants and loans to address all lead hazards in residential properties where a child with an elevated blood lead level is present. **(866) 691-5323**

**Healthy Homes Coalition of West Michigan CLEARCorps Program** – Provides help with checking your home or childcare setting for environmental hazards and prioritizing action. Teaches low-cost interventions. Grand Rapids metro area. **(616) 241-3300**

### Carbon Monoxide

**City of Grand Rapids Housing Rehabilitation Office** – Low-interest, low-payment loans for homeowners to make emergency repairs like furnaces. **(616) 456-3030**

**Healthy Homes Coalition of West Michigan** – Has carbon monoxide detector installation program for low-income families with children. Currently out of funding for purchasing detectors, but hopes to be back up and running soon. Grand Rapids metro area. **(616) 241-3300**

### Radon

**Kent County Health Department** – Do-it-yourself radon test kits for purchase for \$5.00. Pick up your kit at the Environmental Health Division at **700 Fuller Ave NE in Grand Rapids.**
